Rule 1: Licensing is important

Rule 3: Wagering requirements

Validity

The validity of sports welcome bonuses should also be addressed. As you can see, the terms and conditions section is your friend, so be on the look for this important requirement. Smaller deals will usually require less time to be fulfilled, but sometimes **this may apply for others** as well

Rule 5: Markets are important



If a welcome offer is available only for a sports betting market you are not accustomed to, it's always better to pass it by. Fortunately for punters, most sports betting promotions **apply to all sports**, so the chances of having challenges in that department are slim.

Rule 6: Have in mind payment methods



Some of the financial services included at some of the best sports betting sites might be excluded from the claiming process of promotions. That's why we strongly encourage our readers to **read the available terms and conditions** carefully. Usually, those are Skrill and Neteller, but some operators might surprise you.

Rule 7: Use the bonuses for fun

Whether you're an experienced player or you're just getting started with sports betting, **remember to have fun**.
